**Particulars of organization, functions and duties**

[Section 4(1)(b)(i)]

**1. Aims and objectives of the organization :**

The main aim and objective for establishment of territorial Division at Paralakhemundi is (i) to protect the existing natural forests, (ii) management of forests (iii) to promote the degraded forests (iv) to implement the various scheme works for the upliftment of the public and standardize the income level of the rural poor etc. under management plan. To systemizing the objectives, forest department code 1979 has vital roll basing upon which this Division undertakes execution of works following the prescriptions of the working plan. The code has defined the scope of the functions of the Officers of the Forest Department in Orissa working under the administrative control of Forest & Environment Department. The rules under this code is complementary to those laid down in All India Service Manual, Orissa Service Code, Orissa General Financial Rules, Bihar and Orissa Account Code and Orissa Treasury Code. It also confers to apply the General Rules and Government Circulars as amended time to time to the business of the Forest Department unless specifically stated in this code. Besides, this code provides the duties and responsibilities of all the Officers of Forest Department and for implementation of the existing Acts & Rules made there under. The code is divided in V parts in XXVI Chapters. **Part I** describes on Constitution of State Forest, **Part II** confers on Kenduleaf Trade, **Part III** is meant for procedure of Accounts and forest produce stock, **Part IV** is Office Business and **Part V** refers other Miscellaneous matters. The main objective of the Division to under take the execution of various forestry works based on the prescription of the Working Plan prepared for the Division. The working Plan of Paralakhemundi Division has been prepared by Smt. P.Mecro, I.F.S, the then W.P.O., Bhanjanagar, the period of the plan is for ten years from 2006-07 to 2015-16.

**2. Mission / Vision :**

The duties of the D.F.O rests for proper management of the forest business and the finance of the Division. He is to take an active part of all technical works subject to the prescription of the working plan and any direction he may receive from his superior officer. He will control the silviculture operations and to ensure correctness of all technical operations. Besides he is look the general management of the forest situated in his Division and poses direct control over the forest establishment employed therein. He requires implementing the transit rules and shall prevent illegal and illicit transit of forest produce from his division. He should also ensure for implementation all Acts. and Rules made there under various forest & Wildlife Acts.

**3. BRIEF HISTORY AND BACKGROUND FOR IT ESTABLISHMENT :**

The Office Establishment is functioning at Paralakhemundi with its headquarters at Paralakhemundi.. This Division is divided in to 7 Forest Ranges, 26 sections and 95 beats. Each Range is headed with one Range officer, sections are headed by Forest section Officers and Beat is functioned under a beat Officer i.e. Forest Guard. The following staffs are working in Division Office: The duties and responsibilities of all field functionaries i.e. Range Officers, Foresters &

Forest Guards has been enshrined under provision 29 to 36 in the Orissa Forest Department Code, 1979.

## 5. ALLOCATION OF BUINESS:

Part IV of OFD code confers Office business in chapter XXIV. The general system of office business runs as per Orissa record manual, 1964. For smooth management office business, this Division has been divided in to 5 section as 1F, 2F,3F, 4F, 5F etc.

1F: **Accounts Section** The section has been allocated with all accounts matter such as budget, submission of monthly cash account, furnishing of returns & report concerning to all financial matters and transactions. Besides the section has been allocated with Various scheme works like FDA,RSVY, NREGS, Bio diseal etc.

2F: **Establishment Section:** This section has been allocated with the works pertaining to Establishment matter such as, Service verifications of staff, process for sanctioning of increments, fixation of pay, pension, retirements, proceedings, Transfer & posting of staff and other establishment related works.

3F. **Lease Section** This section is allocated with the works of lease matters such as auction sale, issue of TT permits, forest Coupes working and other related lease matter following the working plan prescription and Forest Contract rules/code etc.

4F: **Miscellaneous Section:** All matter other than shown against 1F,2F, 3F,5F section. This section allocated with works mainly initiating Forest Consolidation works, Forest settlement works, Proposals for Reservation Notifications under Orissa Forest Action ie section 4 (i) and 21 notification, Forest diversion proposals, grant of mining clearance, Grant of Prakruti mitra and Prakruti bandhu Awardr, District Environment Society, Wildlife matter etc.

5F: **Offence Section:** The section deals with Forest Offence case matter like wildlife offence, confiscation proceeding against the vehicles involved in forest offence under Orissa Forest Act, 1972, Wildlife Protection Act, etc.

**J.B.I.C Cell** A cell in this office is functioning for execution of OFSDP works assisted by JBIC Japan. The aim and objectives of the project is

- To protect the existing dense natural forests with their bio-diversity, both flora and fauna, and to restore the vigor of natural regeneration through appropriate treatment.
- To improve crown density of degraded forests through reforestation and afforestation.
- To create livelihood alternatives (both based on forest produce and through other income generation activities for the forest dependent communities.
- To enhance capacities of Forest Department, Vana Samarakhsan Samiti (VSS) / Self Help Groups (SHG) community for achieving the long term goal of sustainable forest management and technology up gradation in forestry sector.

This 7 Yr. Project (from 2006-07 to 2012-13) will be implemented in 14 Forest /Wildlife Divisions in 10 districts of the State with total project outlay of Rs. 6598 million.

#### **6. Duties to be performed to achieve the mission:**

**DFO** - He is the administrative head of the Division: The Division Management rests on him. The duties as embodied in O.F.D.Code under provision 20.

**A.C.F** - He is to Assist in management of forests of the Division as embodied under provision 26 of the OFD Code.

**Range Officer** =The Range Officer is in charge of the Range:. He is responsible for forest protection and management of forests under his Range jurisdiction. He is to carry out all the works, check and control in his Range as approved by the Division. He should work as per working plan prescription. He is to prevent to the best of his ability and misuse of authority by subordinates. He should see that the departmental rules are strictly followed .H eis is to supervise all works undertaken by the forest contractors. The duties of the Range Officer is enshrined under provision 28 of the OFD Code.

**Forester:** He is in-charge of a Section. He is to assist to the best of his ability in carrying out. He is to protect the forest and wildlife and to execute the works entrusted to him. He is to supervise the work of the Forest Contractor. He is to see that the forest rules are strictly followed.

**Forest Guard** He is to remain in charge of his beat. He is to maintain fence in good condition. He is to tend the areas under regeneration and weeding young plants wherever necessary, Tending of plantation. He is to see the provisions under wildlife protection Act, 1972 and rules framed thereunder. He is to look after the forest roads and maintenance of boundary pillars, building in his beat. It is also his duty to supervise the works of Forest Contractors in his beat area. His main duty is to patrol over the forest areas under his beat to prevent forest offence.

#### **7. Details of services rendered :**

For the smooth management of the Division Administration, the organization is functioning with 177 nos of staff as detailed above in organization chart..

#### **8. Citizens interaction :**

All scheme works such as JBIC, FDA, RSVY. NREGS are being undertaken under this Division with the active involvement of VSSs and villagers

Further the smugglers are also attracted to the valuable forests of the above three Ranges for their personal gain. They are entering into the forest with lethal arms and weapons with gang in the dead night. Similarly the forest area of Chandragiri and Mohana Range are adjoining to Ghumsur South Division are also theft prone areas.

#### A.P.R. Unit.

One A.P.R. Unit posted to this Division and this has been withdrawn. It is necessary for re-posting of the A.P.R. unit withdrawn from this Division to help the forest staff in gang patrolling works in the theft prone areas of this Division. In this regard the higher Authority also requested to appraise concerned notice authorities as well as to Principal C.C.F, Orissa for reattachment of the APR Unit to Paralakhemundi division in the interest of the Govt. and save the valuable forest of this Division and wildlife of lakhary valley Elephant Sanctuary vide this office memo No. 2550 dtd. 6.5.2005.
